1. Review CFTSS Capacity Survey Results
 - Discussion about agencies applying for new licensure. OMH reps shared that licensure comes from field office that serves area based on agency's administrative address. Currently, there are not any new requests for licensure/designation.
 - Discussion of designated/not providing & designated with immediate openings.
 - Note that some agencies are entering into MOU to provide some services due to no staff for CPST.

2. Discuss C&F Subcommittee Meeting for Survey Review and Action Steps including speakers re: services in during the "new" school year, continued/creative teleMH strategies
 - Decision to move C&F meeting from Sept 25 to Oct 30, 1pm in order to give time for agencies to report out on working under new school year openings.
 - NY Governor executive order for telehealth set to expire August 5. It is expected that an additional 30 day renewal will be signed. Permanent telehealth changes are pending with CMS. Release of any potential changes from CMS might be in September/October.
