

Mid Hudson RPC Board Meeting September 17, 2018 Dutchess County Department of Behavioral and Community Health Meeting Minutes

- Welcome & Introductions
- Approval of Minutes from May Meeting
  - o Approved by N. Batson
  - o Second by Dean Scher
- Bylaws/Board Terms
  - Discussion regarding board terms perused. Majority ruled that board terms would be 3 years. There is no limit to the number of terms an individual can hold. DCS, MCO and state partners will remain the same all other stakeholder groups will be determined by elections. The board agreed that the elections should be staggered to avoid complete turn over.

## • Discussion of Issues

- Marcie reviewed the 5 state issues identified and the results of the survey monkey to prioritize the issues.
  - The top prioritized issue was the sustainability off article 28, 31, & 32 clinics followed by the concern related to confidentiality/consents and data sharing.
    - The third prioritized issue was peer reimbursement, then the intersection of BH and criminal justice, followed by the need to align contracting process for children's services
- We will establish small task forces to collect date and dig deeper into these issues in preparation for report to the state.
