# Children and Families Subcommittee – Alicia Ruperd/Lindsey Newvine- Last meeting held June 18, 2019

- Last meeting had low attendance but had a great conversation- Conversation has focused around the current Children MMC transition timelines and how the rollout has been going
- A taskforce will be developed to focus on the children's workflow
- Feeling that providers are still learning more and more about the transition, before the agencies can come to the meeting with issues-

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- Suggestion to have Lindsey present to the community around CFTSS- CLMHD will develop PPT for larger educational materials
- Suggestions to utilize the regional Care Collaborative to do some education or regional PCP offices
- Lindsey did attend a recent meeting with C-YES, still are a lot of questions
- Leesa from CHUNNY reported that they have been doing HH specific trainings to regional PCPs
- Next Steps-
  - Outreach Joey to do a regional trainings for pediatricians around CFTSS
  - o Beth working on setting up a specific training for St Lawrence county
  - o Next meeting will be held in October- Focus on next parts of the roll out

# HARP/HCBS/Health Homes Workgroup – Angela Doe/Jessica Gonyou-Last meeting held May 24, 2019- Next Meeting September 2019

- Meetings have been very focused
- Last meeting the focus was around the HARP/HCBS workflow
  - o Fidelis presented on their workflow and a list of their regional contacts
  - o MCTAC Matrix list was shared which also lists the regional contact lists
  - Review of the various HCBS services- Will look to hold a future training (at the next HHH
    meeting) that focuses on the breakdown of the HCBS services and what is available in
    the region- Will be a panel event
  - o OMH encouraged attendees to always outreach to OMH Central F/O with questions

#### o Next steps:

- September Panel Event to review what the HCBS services are
- Use Data from OMH to track HCBS utilization- Review the history at the next meeting- Has there been an impact based on the RCAs?
- Create regional directory of regional supervisors to help with communication with the high number of staff turnover
- Considering utilizing the standardization HCBS referral form that the Cap.
   Region RPC created

#### **State Partners Report Out**

#### OMH

- Joe Simko from OMH Central F/O- Reviewed recent HARP/HCBS dashboard Data ( see attachment)
- Joe is collecting qualitative data from providers on how HARP/HCBS is impacting people-HCBS has been successful in some part of the state and is having positive impact on people who are enrolled in HCBS services
- o Innovation Infrastructure- OMH is hopeful that this will also help increase the uptake
- o Possible reasons why uptake has been slow in the Tug Hill region
  - Lack of providers
  - Lack of education on the HARP/HCBS workflow- This is the reason why the HHH workgroup has focused on this

#### Additional OMH updates

- Joe will work on putting together growth charts for the Tug Hill region, per requested from the board
- HCBS providers have gone through a recent attestation process- 7% of providers were de-designated
- recently some additional policy/procedures for these service providers
- Question from the board- Does OMH know the reasons why people may be declining HCBS services? CMs are collecting this information if a person is declining services- Some feedback from consumers has been that they just don't want another provider in their lives
- What is the reason for the low percentage of the HCBS claimed vs other parts of the states
  - Possible reasons could include, the small number of HCBS providers-Some misinformation around the roles and not completely understanding the HCBS services- Will hope that the conversations occurring at the HHH workgroup with help increase communication between HCBS providers and CMs

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- Question from the board- are Children providers outreaching to adults provider to lean about lessons learned? DOH and OMH are in constant contact
- Positive feedback from Karen Boliver that so far they have had success on the children's side due to the relationships/networks that they have been working on building
- On the other hand- it is difficult to build relationship with providers who are outside of your region (ex: CFTSS)- Leads to the importance of networking yourself

#### MEMO update-

- ACT will no longer be part of the HH- people who are receiving services through ACT will not be enrolled in the HH (See Attached Memo)
- First three CFTSS services are now available for UM from MCOs ( see attached Memo)

#### • OASAS-Allie MacPherson- Program Manager from OASAS Central FO

- Reviewed structure of the Central OASAS regional office- Going through multiple staffing changes
- Reviewed Joint Reviews updated process- is now housed under the regional offices/along with program reviews- starting with OP services, eventually rolling out to all services- Feedback has been that this new process has been more efficient
- Feedback from Jim Scordo- Discussed that Opioid epidemic has been a stressor on OASAS and SUD providers and may be why not many SUD providers have gone down the HCBS path

#### **Update on Tug Hill Symposium**

- Purpose of this event will to bring down the various initiatives that are occluding in the NC and Tug Hill region- to get a better understanding of its initiatives focus/scope and purpose and see what gaps remain
- If you are interested in taking part of the planning process for the Tug Hill Symposium please contact Beth- Group will review what the clear purpose of this event will be
- Barry will take the lead for facilitating the event
- Will look to hold this event in the Fall of 2019

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#### **Open Floor**

- Beth will continue to send the Children's updates in a complied email once a week
- Beth will start to start to send out the Tug Hill RPC monthly newsletter again
- Katie Molanare provided an update on the Statewide Workforce Taskforce and Central RPC workforce
  - Statewide- Has been adding reps from additional parts of the state- Conversations around looking at new/innovative HR benefits
    - Look to create a state survey to send to BH providers to get a understanding of wants/needs- Working with OASAS/OMH to see if they already have something existing
  - Central Region- Created a drop off tracking to ask CM of why people are dropping off the in the process, top three responses were:
    - 1. Refused
    - 2. No show/no call
    - 3. didn't like the services
  - Held a CM Town Hall event in May- CM reports burn out due to documentation and number of calls/decrease in the direct contact with clients
    - Will be holding CM roundtables to determine where they want to go next-how do they address the needs/wants identified in the CM survey they recently collected- CMs reported they don't feel that they know the services in their own community and how to keep themselves safe in the community ( personal safety training with the PPS)
  - o Next steps- does the Tug Hill want to share survey in this region?

Update from CHUNNY- Leesa Harvey- Dowdle; Gave an update on the enrolment in CHUNNY in the Tug Hill region- CHUNNY willing to go out to agencies to come and talk about Health Homes

Will be training their CM's on chronic conditions

Credo is having an Open House tomorrow. On their new barn facility- 24180 County Rt 16

APG rates have been flat- there now has been some recent movement on this- Effective June  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ .
