<b>Update</b>	Ulster County continues to struggle with our housing market. The going rate of rental units far exceed what is considered fair market. This makes even subsidized and supported housing programs inaccessible. One of our contract agencies was awarded 20 forensic beds through OMH, however had to turn down the award due to the funding being inefficient to make the program operational. There has been some movement in expanding opportunities for emergency housing for those with Substance Use Disorder, although that program is continuously scrutinized by the community for its harm reduction approach. Our LGU experienced the retirement of our long-time Residential SPOA Coordinator this spring, which presents the opportunity to rethink the way we run SPOA in our county.
